2. Publication:

The combined issue of PJC Vol. 16 No. 2 and Vol. 17 No. 1 (December 1985 and June 1986) is now off the press and is ready for distribution.

3. The Linguistic Society of the Philippines, in cooperation with the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, the Philippine Normal College-Ateneo de Manila University – De La Salle University Consortium, the British Council, the United States Information Service and under the sponsorship of the Fund for Assistance to Private Education, conducted a summer workshop on “Materials Preparation for English Language Teaching” the first in a new five-year plan of activities (1985-1989). Participants of this workshop were composed of English supervisors from the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports and heads, coordinators and chairpersons of English programs in selected universities from the 13 regions of the Philippines. The workshop was held from April 15 to May 10, 1985 at De La Salle University. Facilitators/lecturers for this year’s summer workshop were Graham Millington of the British Council, Thomas Kral and Jean Bodman of the USIS.
4. The annual meeting of the Linguistic Society of the Philippines was held on May 4 at the Waldo Perfecto Seminar Room of De La Salle University. The theme of the convention was “Agenda for the Twenty-First Century: The Modernization of Filipino.” The speakers were Dr. Nelly Cubar, Dr. Soledad Reyes, Dr. Isagani Cruz, Dr. Bienvenido Lumbea, Dr. Fe T. Otones, Dr. Michael Walrod, Dr. Elmer Wolfenden, Mr. Richard Hohulin and Mrs. Lou Hohulin. The keynote speaker was Prof. Salustiano Tengonciang. The evaluation of the 10-year old Bilingual Education Program (1974-1984) is now in its final stage. The data are now being analyzed and the final write-up is now being written. The project is expected to be finished by December of 1986. This project is being sponsored by the Asia Foundation, Ford Foundation, PRODED and NEDA-AID.
