## Abstract of "China's Sense of Responsibility Towards Liberation Movements"

About the validity of China's responsibility towards national liberation movements and its integration in the Chinese foreign policy, a few cases like the liberation of Bangla Desh in 1971 made the question arise of the role and functions of such a promotion of a world revolution. The analysis of the content and use of the ideological discourse, and, more specifically, the study of the Chinese position in East Pakistan up to the independence of Bangla Desh demonstrate that, in fact, the constantly reasserted revolutionary leadership is a national strategy for the consolidation of the Chinese State and regime. Its functions are directly related to a policy of protection of the Chinese revolution and recognition of the international liberation movements reveal to the expression of a strategy of survival and thus, are conditioned by the imperatives of Chinese national security and international strengthening objectives.
