Provinces covered are Abra, Ilocos Norte, Ilocos Sur, La Union and Mountain Province.

Contents: Parts One to Five and Part Seven have the same headings and sub-headings as the corresponding sections in IPC Regional Handbook No. 2. Part Six contains introductions to both Iloko and Ibanag. Provinces covered are Batanes, Cagayan, Isabela, and Nueva Vizcaya.
