This PSR issue presents attempts of social science scholars to scrutinize the use of secondary sources, the choice of supposedly "knowledgeable" respondents, the replication of theoretical models, and the invention of predictive scales.

Again we stress the need for more "dialogue" among social scientists that would be geared to the refinement of sociological anthropological theory and method on Philippine society, culture and personality.

All manuscripts should be submitted in double spaced typescript with liberal

margins. No galley proofs will be sent to the authors unless explicitly requested.
