

Abstract of "Political Analysis from a Sociological Viewpoint"

Political scientists are enjoined to employ a sociological practice called "debunking", a task which looks beneath the facades of political structures and which exposes the fallaciousness of socially established definition of reality. The task is inherently subversive of conventional patterns of thought, but it constitutes the first important step in practicing sociology and political science in good faith. Some general implications of "debunking" vis-a-vis the institutional order are presented.
