Introduction

This is an index to all the issues of the PHILIPPINE SOCIOLOGICAL REVIEW, a quarterly, from Vol. 1, 1953 to Vol. 35, 1987 except for a few unpublished numbers namely:

Vol. 2, Nos. 1 and 4

All articles are fully indexed. Each one has an author entry, (if available) and at least one subject. Some articles have as many as 3 or more subjects. Editor's notes/prefaces (if available) are also included.

All entries are in one alphabetical order.

Directions for Use

All entries - authors and subjects - are arranged alphabetically.

Entries under personal names are either BY or ABOUT the person. The articles under each personal name are arranged alphabetically by author (if available) and title of the article. The last name of the person is in capital letters.

Subjects are in capital letters. The entries under each subject are arranged alphabetically by author (if available) and title of the article.
