Manuscripts are solicited for this *Journal*. Articles submitted for consideration should be approximately 5,000 words, typewritten double spaced on 8 1/2" by 11" bond paper. The style, especially with reference to footnoting and headings, should follow that found in this *Journal*. Contributors should enclose a brief biographical sketch together with the manuscripts and abstracts of approximately 100 words.
