

Editorial Note

Volume XV of the Philippine Sociological Review starts with a special issue on the proceedings of the Fifth Visayas-Mindanao Convention on May 1-2, 1967 at the Victorias Milling Company, Victorias, Negros Occidental. In an attempt, though meager, to plot the course where the Philippines is going, varied aspects of socio-cultural changes, urbanization and industrialization, especially in the rural areas, were discussed. More extensive and intensive inquiry along this view is anticipated.

The up-to-date publication of the PSR has been set back mainly because of the lag in the submission of articles that favorably measure up to the norm of testing facts, theory and methodology in yielding insights on Philippine society and culture. We earnestly hope that more efforts will be thus directed. News items on the activities of sociologists and anthropologists involved in research on the Philippines here and abroad, book reviews, suggestions, critiques and other articles that will gen-

erate the healthy growth of social science are most welcome.

All manuscripts should be submitted in double spaced typescript with liberal margins. No galley proofs will be sent to the authors unless explicitly requested.

The articles and comments printed in the PSR do not represent the views of either the Philippine Sociological Society or of the editors. The editors are responsible only for the selection and acceptance of material submitted. Responsibility for opinions expressed in the articles and comments contained in them rests solely with the authors.
