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SOCIAL WEATHER STATIONS SURVEY OF PUBLIC OPINION ON THE DECEMBER 1, 1989 COUP ATTEMPT

500 GMA voting-age adults, December 11-18, 1989. Error margin: +/- 5%.

SUMMARY

Coup attempt of 1989 even more unpopular than that of 1987.

Pro-government forces again seen as heroes, and rebels as villains:

Presidential performance rating bounces back up.

Rebel rationalizations for coup have basis as factual social conditions, but do not justify coup.

Rebel intentions no longer given benefit of the doubt.

Public wants tougher disciplinary action against rebels.

Even if rebels won, the public would not have collaborated.

US assistance appreciated, but public attitude towards military bases is unchanged.

No to martial law; yes to declaring state of emergency; however, present powers are enough to deal with it.

Call is for Laurel and Enrile, not Aquino, to resign.

Other unpopular figures are Maceda, Reyes, Concepcion, Quisumbing.






